From Thomas Boylan of Rome, GA, "The Barnes Family," p. 5 (no date):

"Jacob BARNES of Isle of Wight was said to have been the brother of Joshua BARNES, a professor of Greek at Cambridge University, (Stanard - Some Emigrants to VA:10). Jacob is said to have gone to visit his brother Joshua in Hemingford, England. Joshua was the son of EDWARD BARNES who about 1618 was an 'Adventurer in the Va. Company of London' (correspondence on Barnes family)."

REGARDING EDWARD BARNES, THE "ADVENTURER" WHO CAME TO VIRGINIA: Whether or not he was the Edward Barnes of St. Botolph without Bishopsgate Parish, London, England, is unknown.

The "adventurer" Edward was the son of Alice, widow Barnes, who married (2) Dr. Lawrence Bohunne, who was the first physician general of the London Company appointed for service in the Jamestown colony, serving from June 1610 until March 1621, when Dr. Bohunne was killed in the West Indies on his way from England to Virginia on the Margaret and John, Captain Chester. Two Spanish men-of-war in the West Indies attacked the ship, and Dr. Bohun was killed. This information is from: Sidney S. "On October 31, 1621, Virginia Company officials reviewed a petition submitted to them by Alice, the widow of Dr. Lawrence Bohunne. She asked that her son, Edward Barnes, be freed from his seven year's service. Mrs. Bohunne's request was denied for it was determined that Edward Barnes was a Virginia Company Servant, not one of Dr. Bohunne's men. On February 16, 1623, Edward Barnes was living in Elizabeth City." Dr. Bohunne had died in a Spanish attack in the West Indies on 3/19/1621. [Also spelled Bohun / Bohune.] This information is from "Virginia Immigrants and Adventurers, 1607-1635; A Biographical Dictionary" by M. W. McCartney, published 2007.

'LAWRENCE BOHUNE of London, Doctor in Phisicke. Will 10 March 1620; proved 29 April 1622. My wife Alice to have all my estate, but if she married only one half and the other half to be divided among our children, viz: Elizabeth Bohune, Edward Barnes, Anne Barnes, and Dorothy Barnes, my daughter Elizabeth to 10 pounds over and above my wife's children. Residuary Legatee and Executrix: Wife Alice. Witnesses: John . . . (sic) Thomas Nicolls, Nichol Gibson, Tho. Tailor, Ed. Constable.
