[7] James M. Mangum was only 19 when he was killed. The reason is not known. It is rumored to be a woman or a crop dispute. This story was told to Gene Cole by his great aunt, Dora (Mangum) Robinson in August 1981. She was just four months old when he was shot in the fall of 1886. His mother had been riding a horse through Richland township in Ozark Co., MO, when she heard the gunshot. She knew it was her son, she told her granddaughter Dora later. The culprit had waited in ambush. When Jim was dying, he handed his gun to George Payne and told him to shoot the man who'd shot him. Apparently Payne didn't follow through. Soon after Jim died, his widow gave birth to their first child, Russell.
