Dianne Doyle Stevens, distevens@comcast.net, a descendant of John S. Barnes's daughter, Mary Elizabeth, had notes from her father about the names of the siblings of John: William, Bennett, Robert, and Mary. She emailed this information to Cecilie Gaziano at cgaziano1@gmail.com on 06 Sep 2014.

Joseph M. Barnes, b. 1826 AL, and Robert Jasper Barnes, b. 1828 AL, both in the 1850 Lafayette Co., MS, census are likely to be the sons of Robert.

Descendants of both of these men match Cecilie Gaziano (descendant of John S. Barnes) at a 4th cousin to 6th cousin level, which strengthens the possibility that these men are Robert's sons and therefore grandsons of William Barnes and Sarah Sanderson, last found in Lafayette County, MS, in the 1840 census.

Note from Cecilie Gaziano, cgaziano1@gmail.com: Joseph M. Barnes's 1880 census says his father was born in Tennessee and his mother in Alabama. The 1880 census for Robert Jasper Barnes says his father was born in Tennessee and his mother in Virginia. Of course, we know censuses are not 100% reliable for parents' birth information, but it appears that we can be fairly safe in saying Robert, son of William & Sarah (Sanderson) Barnes was born either in Sumner Co. or Montgomery Co., TN. I'm guessing Robert was born about 1807, and he was their first child.

William Barnes, Sr., was in the 1830 Fayette County, Tennessee, and 1840 Lafayette County, Mississippi, censuses, the only censuses there are for him (except as a child in the 1790 census with Joseph Barnes, Edgecombe Co., NC) because his earlier years were in Sumner Co., TN; Montgomery Co., TN; and Madison Co., AL, for which no early census survives.

"Before leaving by steamboat for New Orleans to await ships for Texas, the First Mississippi Regiment elected Jefferson Davis of Warren County as its colonel. Davis was serving as a congressman from Mississippi, and would later, during the American Civil War, be president of the Confederate States. Davis was a West Point graduate who had already served in the U. S. Army. When he took command in New Orleans, his thorough training and constant drilling shaped the Mississippians into an outstanding unit that became the recognized favorite of General Taylor. Colonel Davis had another link with General Taylor: he was his son-in-law. Some years before, Colonel Davis had married General Taylor's daughter, who died only a few months after the wedding. Of particular note was Colonel Davis's insistence that his men be given the very newest type of rifle. They became so good with them that the
