Davis was a West Point graduate who had already served in the U. S. Army. When he took command in New Orleans, his thorough training and constant drilling shaped the Mississippians into an outstanding unit that became the recognized favorite of General Taylor. Colonel Davis had another link with General Taylor: he was his son-in-law. Some years before, Colonel Davis had married General Taylor's daughter, who died only a few months after the wedding. Of particular note was Colonel Davis's insistence that his men be given the very newest type of rifle. They became so good with them that the
